Oakland County International Airport is announcing the release of the draft Noise Exposure Maps (NEMs) and the related public hearing information meeting for the FAR Part 150 Study Noise Exposure Map Update. NEMs are the maps that provide the basis for the Airport's Noise Compatibility Program. A public meeting will occur on Thursday, November 10, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m., and will include a short open house, followed by a presentation describing the study progress and present the draft NEMs. Following the presentation, there will be a court recorder to take official public comments. The meeting will be held at the Oakland County International Airport Main Terminal, 6500 Highland Road in Waterford, MI. The purpose of this meeting is to receive comments from the public on the draft Noise Exposure Map Update. The Study is being conducted to update the current and future Noise Exposure Maps to analyze the noise effects caused by aircraft operations at Oakland County International Airport. Airport staff and the consultant team will be available to answer questions at the meeting and receive public comments.
