Rochester Hills woman says her boyfriend jabbed her eye

First, she told police her boyfriend accidentally poked her in the eye while they were horsing around.

But when personnel at Crittenton Hospital Medical Center told the 38-year-old Rochester Hills woman that her pupil was so damaged she may end up blind, she told police there was no accident — her 31-year-old boyfriend stuck his finger in her eye during an argument.

George Nyquist, who lived with the woman, was arraigned Friday by a magistrate via video from the Oakland County Jail on a charge of assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than murder, according to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office today.

He's accused of assaulting his girlfriend at their home on Thursday, police said.

According to police, Nyquist was convicted earlier this year on a separate domestic violence charge involving the same woman. The woman was transported to Royal Oak Beaumont Hospital for further medical treatment.

Capt. Mike Johnson, of the sheriff's office, said Nyquist is still being held in the jail and has not posted bond, which is set at \$5,000 cash or surety.
