## Dark-clad pedestrian killed in Oxford Twp.

A 51-year-old woman was killed Thursday night after two cars hit her while she was walking near the Meijer in Oxford Township, the Oakland County Sheriff's Office said today.


Karen Reynolds, who lived in Oxford Village, had been walking south on Lapeer near Market shortly before 5:45 p.m. when she started to cross the street heading west, according to investigators.

In the left lane, a 2000 Plymouth Voyager driven by a 50-year-old Oxford Township resident hit her and then a 2006 Kia Spectra, driven by a 25-year-old Orion Township resident, struck her when she was lying in the right lane, the county Sheriff's Office said. Both cars were on the southbound side of the street.

Investigators said the area where the accident occurred was unlit and that Reynolds was wearing dark clothing and not walking in a crosswalk.

Alcohol is not believed to be a factor, according to county Sheriff's Office officials. The accident is still being investigated.
