Shooting at Christian motorcycle group's HQ reported

Even a Christian motorcycle group apparently isn't immune to gun violence, according to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office.

A member of Hogs-in-Ministry called the sheriff's office at 11:18 a.m. Monday to report 14 bullet holes shot into the group's Springfield Township headquarters. Investigators were able to recover two bullets from the shooting at the East Holly Road home but do not have any suspects. The resident told investigators the shooting could have happened Sunday or Monday.

The group is a ministry of Faith Baptist Church of Waterford, according to the Web site www.h-i-m.org.

The motorcyclists attend motorcycle rallies and events, including one scheduled for Saturday by the H-I-M chapter in Kalamazoo.

"We have a love for our fellow bikers, but above all, we love the Lord our God," the group's Web site says. "If you are still seeking a group to ride with, or maybe you are questioning your relationship with God, please feel free to just come and ride with H.I.M."

Members of H-I-M could not be reached for comment today.
