## 2 men charged for breaking into nail salon

Two men will be back in court in the coming days after being charged with breaking into a Commerce Township nail salon.

Adam David Gondek, 30, and James Allen Hoover, 24, were charged Sept. 4 with breaking and entering, receiving and concealing stolen property, among other charges. Gondek is being held on \$100,000 bond; Hoover is being held on a \$25,000 bond.

According to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office, a passerby saw the two men in a white Dodge Caravan, which was parked by D Classy Nails on Commerce Road in early on Sept. 3. The passerby noticed that a window was broken at the nail salon and called authorities.

The van was found a short time later; authorities determined it had been recently stolen from Melvindale.

Gondek, of Detroit, was found riding a stolen bicycle near Farr and Commerce roads. Hoover, of Melvindale, was arrested riding a stolen bicycle near Commerce and Sandalwood roads.

Both bicycles had been stolen from homes in the area.
