Drunk man threatens neighbors with gun

Deputies from the Oakland County Sheriff's Department Commerce Township Substation arrested an allegedly intoxicated male in the 2300 block of Gage after receiving a report that he allegedly threatened his neighbor by pointing a gun at him.

Deputies responded to the Sunday, June 27 incident around 10 p.m., and observed the man through a window in his home, where he was apparently drunk and talking to himself, according to a sheriff's department report. Neighbors told sheriff's deputies he told them he had an AK-47.

The man was transported to Oakland County Jail, and several weapons, including a shotgun, a rifle, and knives and ammunition, were confiscated by law enforcement officials.

Sheriff's department officials couldn't be reached for further comment prior to press time.
