Man attacks another at friend's home

Oakland County Sheriff's Department deputies have requested an assault warrant for a Highland Township man following an incident at a residence last weekend.

The Oakland County Sheriff's Department Highland Substation received a 911 call involving an aggravated assault at 3:30 a.m. on Sunday, Nov. 21.

When deputies arrived at the Highlands Hills Mobile Home Park off Beech and Tamarack, they found a male victim bleeding from his head. The 31-year-old man said he came over to his female friend's residence to visit with her and another male friend.

The victim and the 21-years-old woman said their male friend left, and they both fell asleep in the woman's bedroom.

The male suspect, a 19-year-old, came back later and began pounding on the door. The woman's father let him in the house.

The male victim woke up to the male suspect kicking him. The suspect then struck the victim in the head with a glass, which broke and cut the complainant.

The woman's father then pulled the male suspect off the victim and told both to leave the residence. The victim then ran outside to call 911, while the assailant left the residence.

Highland firefighters attended to the complainant's minor injuries. Deputies are currently requesting a warrant against the suspect from the Oakland County Prosecutor's Office for felonious aggravated assault.
