

## 2 Rochester Hills banks the latest to be shot up

### Police say ~~22 attacks have happened~~ at 14 banks

Two banks in Rochester Hills were hit by gunshots late Tuesday, bringing to 22 the number of incidents in which banks have been shot at in Oakland and Macomb counties, according to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office.

At 11:30 p.m., long after the banks had closed, deputies found that windows had been shot at the Bank of America on Rochester Road and the TCF Bank on West Tienken. Police said the cleaning crew at the Bank of America found a bullet hole in the front window and, at the TCF, bullets penetrated the front window near the bank manager's office.

According to police, this was the first time either of these banks had been hit.

Tuesday's incidents were the first since late March, according to police. The 22 incidents have occurred at 14 different banks since August: 10 in Rochester Hills, one in Rochester, one in Oakland Township and two in Washington Township.

In most of the cases, the banks were hit multiple times on multiple occasions with a small caliber firearm, all between 8 p.m. and 3:30 a.m. No one has been injured.

A \$3,500 reward is being offered for the arrest and conviction of those responsible. Tips can be made anonymously. Anyone with information is asked to call 888-887-6146 (888-TURN-1-IN).
