Stolen vehicle found in apartment complex lot

A car stolen out of Waterford Township was discovered Sunday, Sept. 7 in the parking lot of a Highland Township apartment complex.

According to an Oakland County Sheriff's Department report, the manager of Canterbury Commons in Highland stated a gray, four-door Buick was backed into a parking spot in the visitor lot of the the complex. The vehicle was missing its license plate.

When deputies arrived they noted that the vehicle's ignition was tampered with and the left rear passenger window was broken. They also confirmed there was no license plate on the vehicle.

The apartment complex manager told deputies the car had first been seen in the parking lot on Saturday, Sept. 6, at 1 p.m.

Deputies checked the car and confirmed with the Waterford Police Department that the vehicle was stolen out of Waterford.

Sheriff's deputies had the car impounded. The case has been turned over to the Sheriff's Department auto theft unit for further investigation.
