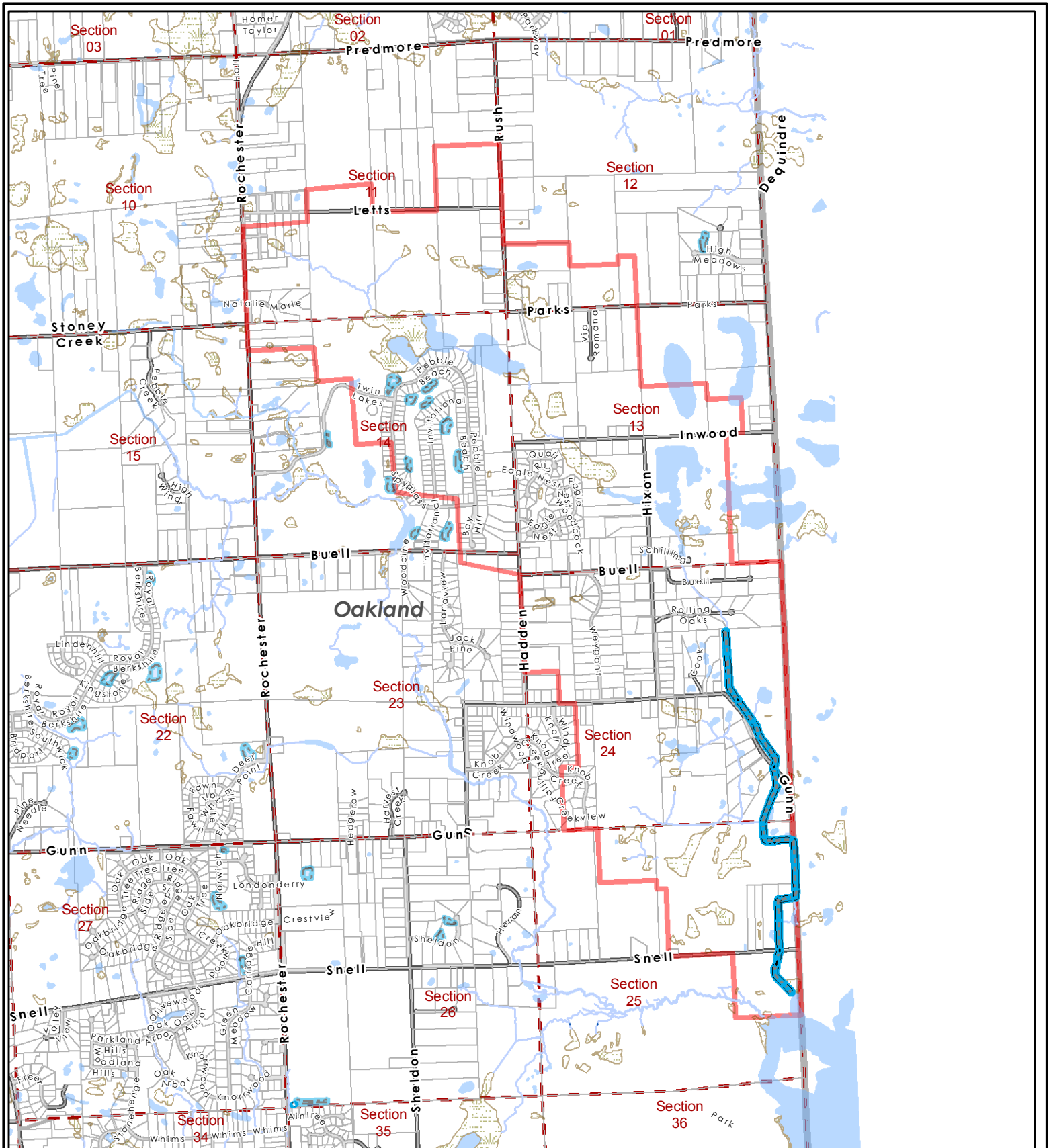


## The McClure Drain

The McClure Drain was established in 1922. The Drain is approximately 2 miles of open ditch and extends from its outlet in a branch of the Stoney Creek northeasterly along the Oakland/Macomb County border through sections 24 and 24 of Oakland Township to its upper terminus northeasterly of the intersection of Gunn Road and Hixon Road. The Drain collects runoff from 1,970 acres. A map indicating the drainage district and the location of the drain is available below.
