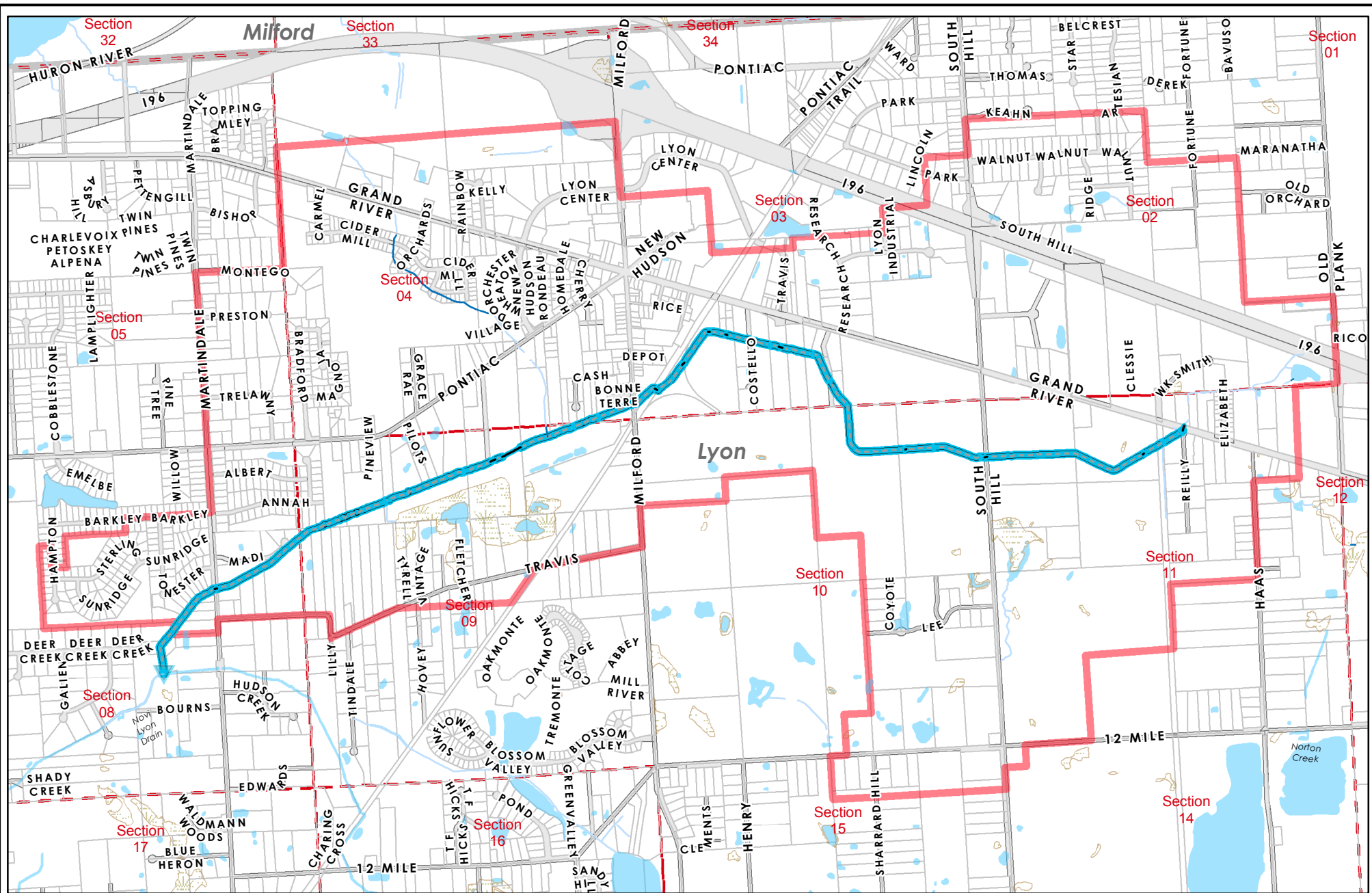


New Hudson No. 1 Drain

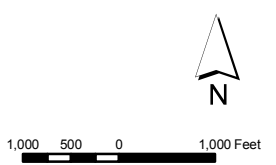
The New Hudson No. 1 Drain is a chapter 4 drain established in 1904 and is approximately 18,525 feet of open ditch. The Drain has its outlet in the Novi and Lyons Drain in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8 in the Township of Lyon, west of Martindale Road and south of Pontiac Trail. From its outlet the drain extends northeasterly through section 8 and section 9 and crossing the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 4 and continuing northeasterly in section 3 to a point on the east side of the Grand Trunk Western Railroad approximately 200 feet south of Grand River Avenue; thence southeasterly crossing the south half of Section 3 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10 and continuing southeasterly in the north half of Section 11 to its upper terminus at Grand River Avenue in the NE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 11 west of Haas Road.
