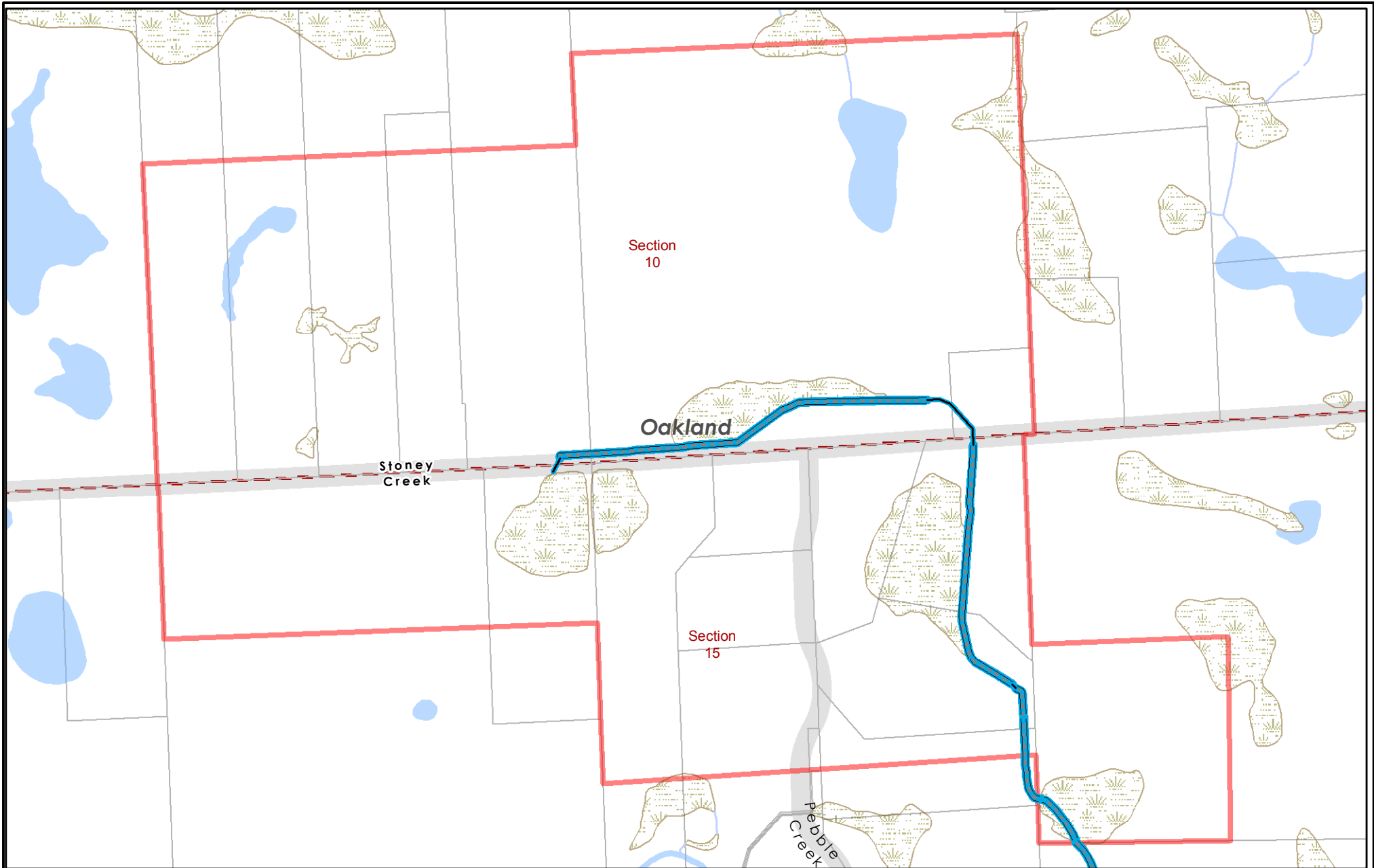


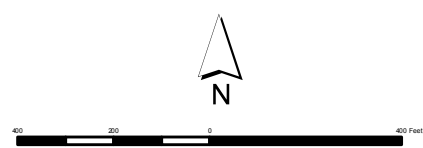
The Shoup Drain

The Shoup Drain was established in 1909. It has its outlet in a branch of the Stoney Creek at a point west of Rochester Road and south of Stoney Creek Road. From its outlet, the drain extends northwesterly to the north side of Stoney Creek Road; thence westerly on the north side of Stoney Creek Road a distance of 1300 feet; thence southerly crossing Stoney Creek Road and continuing to its upper terminus approximately 165 feet south of Stoney Creek Road. The drain is open ditch and is a little over a half mile long. The Drain collects 125 acres. A map indicating the drainage district and the location of the drain is available below.
