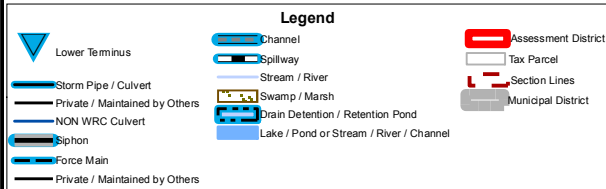
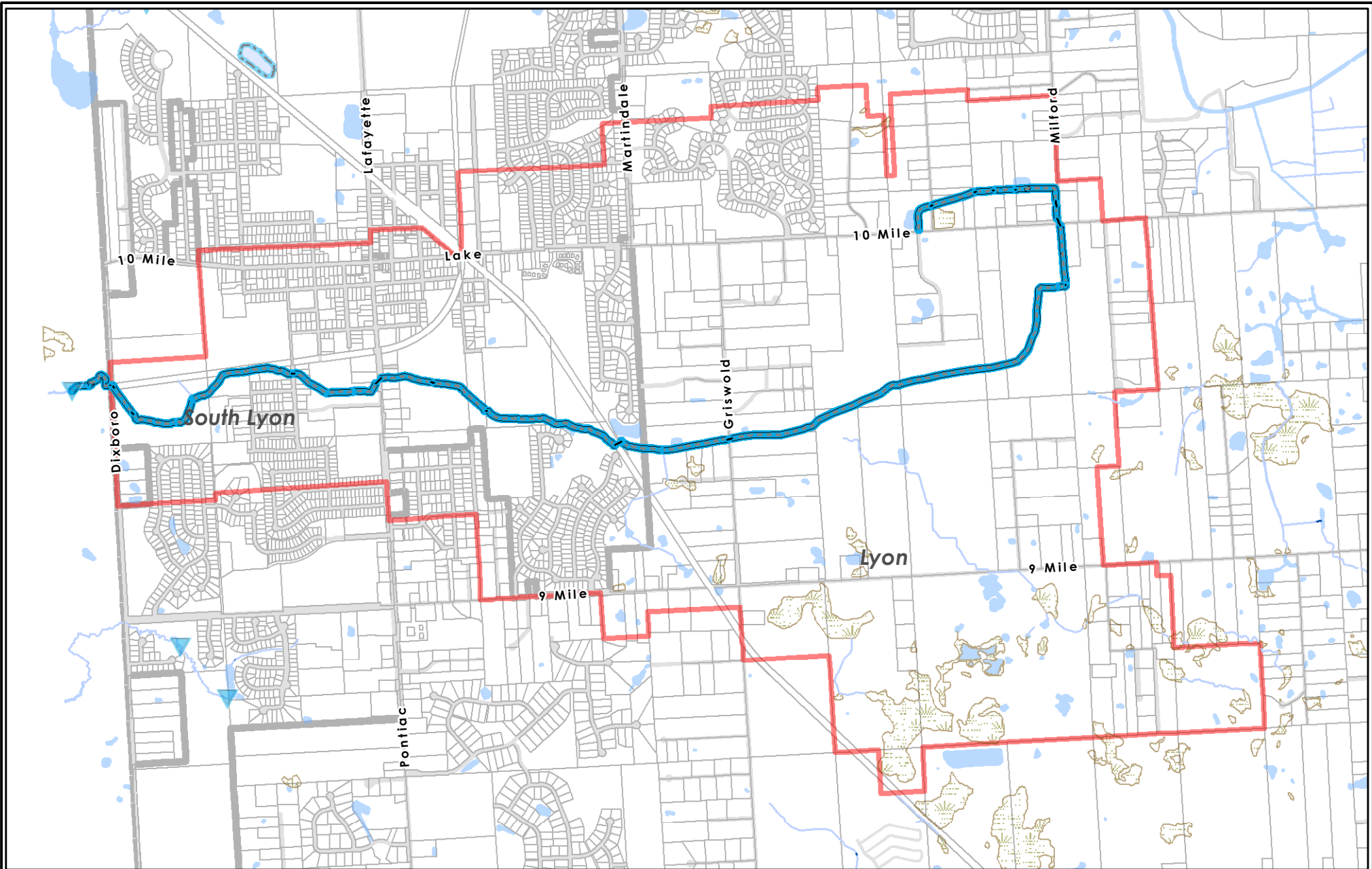


Yerkes Drain

The Yerkes Drain is a chapter 4 drain established in 1904 and is approximately 21,670 feet of open ditch. Its outlet is in the northwest quarter of Section 30 of Lyon Township. From its outlet the drain extends easterly approximately a quarter of a mile through Lyon Township; thence continuing easterly in the City of South Lyon crossing Section 30 to Pontiac Trail; thence continuing easterly through the City of South Lyon and the Township of Lyon to Griswold Road which is on the line between Sections 28 and 29 of the Township of Lyon; thence northeasterly crossing Section 28 to the line between Sections 27 and 28; thence northerly along the section line 10 Mile Road; thence northerly along the section line between Sections 21 and 22 for approximately 600 feet; thence westerly in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21 for approximately 2200 feet; thence southerly approximately 300 feet to its upper terminus at Ten Mile Road.
